

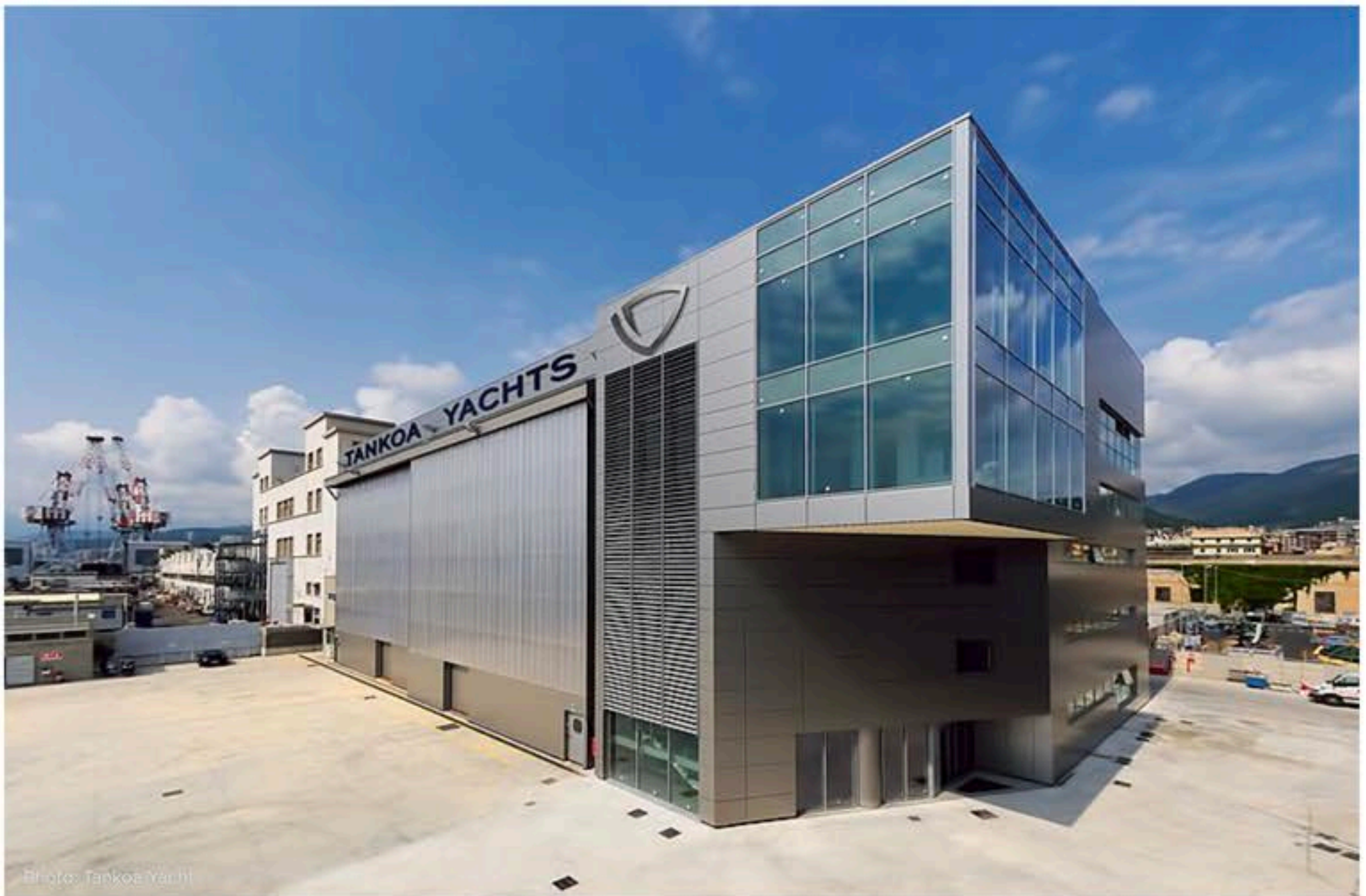
In-build 52m Tankoa Yachts custom project sold

[Tankoa Yachts](#) has announced the sale of a new 52-metre fully-custom yacht. The project has been developed by [Vitruvius Yachts](#) on a new platform and is based on the precise requests of its Canadian owners. Albert McIlroy from [OptimusNavis](#) introduced the owners and will act as their representative throughout the construction process.



The new aluminium yacht has been designed in collaboration with [Vitruvius Yachts Ltd](#), a prestigious partner, and designer [Philippe Briand](#) who has dealt with both the exterior design and naval architecture. The interior design has been signed off by [FM Architettura](#) from Ancona.

The 52-metre project will remain under 500 GT despite its large size, and will be characterised by its remarkable interior design that will be finely decorated, down to the smallest of details. "The project was developed over a year and, once [Tankoa](#) was chosen as the shipyard, it was a pleasure to collaborate with the owners to define the last details of what will surely be a remarkable, pleasant and successful collaboration," says [Tankoa](#) Sales Manager, Claudio Corvino.

Throughout the design process, great attention to detail has been paid to both the development of the hull and its weight. This will create an extremely efficient yacht with reduced consumption that will be emphasised by the hybrid propulsion system and the use of jointly developed [Siemens](#) batteries.

The custom-built [Vitruvius Yachts](#) 52 has an expected delivery date of Spring 2025.
