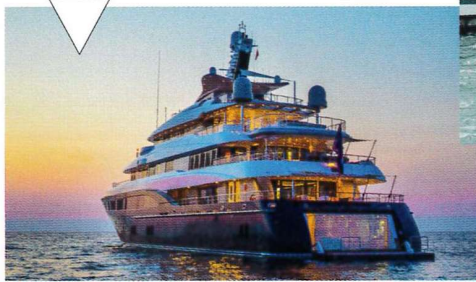

## CARINTHIA VII

New to the charter market for 2024, *Carinthia VII* has a toy box to match the yacht's 97-metre length, including a 10m waterslide that drops screaming guests into the sea from the main deck.

Newly refitted for 2023, 72-metre *Arbema's* 24 crew take guests on adventures using the yacht's diving kit, snorkelling gear and 15-metre chase boat.
